

## Synopsis

Pray, Hope, and Don't Worry: True Stories of Padre Pio, Book II, written by Diane Allen and published by Padre Pio Press, contains 40 chapters and 480 pages. The author continued to research and study the life and spirituality of Padre Pio for her second book on the saint who has often been referred to as "the greatest mystic of the 20th Century." Included in the book are a number of interviews the author conducted with those who met Padre Pio personally and had a testimony to share. One of the personal testimonies in Pray, Hope, and Don't Worry Book II, is the story of the cloistered Carmelite nun, Sister Pia of Jesus Crucified, who found her vocation to religious life on her first visit to San Giovanni Rotondo and made her confession to Padre Pio on many occasions. The testimony of Alex Quinn, popular songwriter and recording artist of Belfast, Northern Ireland is also featured. Alex tells of the miracle his family received through the intercession of Padre Pio. Additional chapters: Padre Pio - An Extraordinary Confessor, Padre Pio's Love for the Holy Angels, The Clergy Remembers Padre Pio, Padre Pio's Gift of Bilocation, Padre Pio's Prophetic Spirit, More Stories from the War Years, Padre Pio's Healing Touch, Padre Pio and the Children, Padre Pio's Seraphic Father: St. Francis of Assisi and much more. When I read *Pray, Hope, and Don't Worry: True Stories of Padre Pio Book I*, the result was my return to the Catholic Church and my resignation from a California-based cult that has snared so many good souls who only wanted to find God but who found evil instead. The goodness and the true presence of God embodied by Padre Pio was so clearly portrayed by the stories in Book I that I thought no other book could bring me closer to Padre Pio and make me feel so clearly and deeply the Love of God. Having read several books on him, including the first book by Diane Allen, I wasn't sure how much new info would be available. Alas, this doesn't disappoint. It is a substantial work at 400+ pages. It isn't dry but could best be read one chapter at a time in order to absorb the rich facts & details about St. Pio and the life he lived. Clearly Ms. Allen put a lot of time into this book and it is well worth a read.

I had read a much of Padre Pio already. He truly was a saint living in my lifetime. I am disappointed that whilst he was alive, I never visited him in San Giovanni Rotondo. On the other hand, I feel exceptionally fortunate in that I have met a recipient of Padre Pio's prayers, & miracles here in Los Angeles. His story, is recalled wonderfully in this book by Diane Allen. His experience of the miracles he received strengthened my faith in God too. He attends Mass at our local Capuchin parish in greater LA. I found this book to be an enjoyable and easy read, although in excess of 440 pages. I read this in about a week. All in all a fascinating collection of very readable stories that tell a great deal of St Pio's life. It has been a positive experience for me to read this book, and I am very happy, that I found it!

The measure of a good book, especially in inspirational reading, is that you can read this more than once. I have already read it 3 times. That's the only way things can sink in. You read it once to know what it's about, a 2nd time to catch all the parts you missed and 3 or more times to let the information sink in. Padre Pio was an amazing priest with special gifts given to him by God. This book gives you a true picture of his gifts and life.
