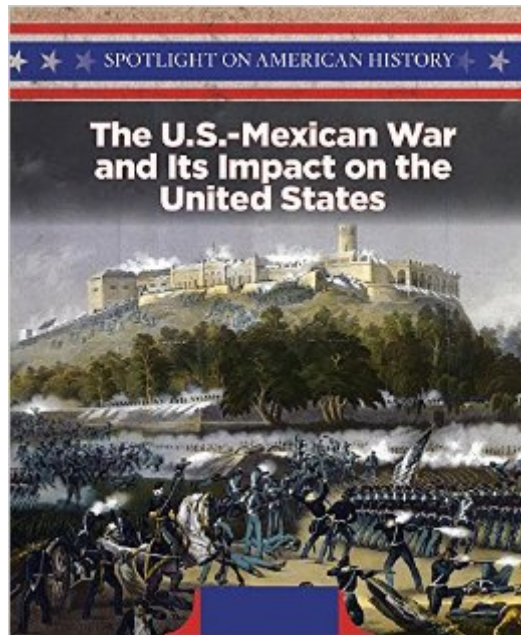


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The U.s.-mexican War And Its Impact On The United States (Spotlight On American History)
