

We bought this book along with the study guide for my husband to use in leading his Wednesday night Bible study. The book is enjoyable to read and informative, typical MacArthur. The workbook has application questions and is actually rather lengthy. I do wish the book came in paperback to lessen the cost. After perusing it, it seems it will work out great for the Bible study (material is suitable length in each chapter, good questions to guide discussions). My husband said he wished there were a Leader's edition that would have extra notes just for the leader, but the study guide did

have some notes for that purpose (just not as much as what he wanted). The book springs from a series of sermons he gave on the subject, so the men are fleshed out and brought to life with plenty of application, rather than just being the run-of-the-mill information that everyone already knows. I think you'll find it very interesting.

This was a great help to utilize the book in group discussion. Twelve ordinary men tell the story of the twelve disciples of Jesus and shows them in a light that allows us to know them as individuals with various gifts, talents, and weaknesses as our own. I was thrilled a workbook was available to complement this book. The book arrived in good condition, was well packaged and offers great questions to guide conversation and thought.

John MacArthur is a very good author. He gives you a whole new view of the Disciples as everyday people. The workbook is very deep and takes a while to finish, but it is well worth it. Give it a chance, I don't think you'll regret it.

We got this for my husband to use in a Bible study he leads. It has LOTS of questions, almost so many you wonder if the people will get through them. They are, of course, very good application questions as would be typical of MacArthur. He wishes there was more info just for the leader or a separate leader's guide to ease preparation, though there are some leader notes in the guide. Overall, very good and highly recommended. Guess he got pampered by another Bible study series we used that came complete with leader's guide and extra info to use! BTW, most of the questions are application oriented and thus have lots of lines to write out your answers and thoughts, hence the number of pages.

We have been looking for ways to make the lessons and stories of the life and times of Christ more applicable to today's life. This course does that! The workbook is long and can easily allow you to make the classroom experience last beyond 14 weeks. The workbook breaks each lesson into thought-provoking sessions with 4 sections of homework and a daily reading assignment with the questions. The sections each work a different angle for the material and work directly with a chapter in the book and the scripture readings during the book. The first section - Another Look - has the reader review the chapter. The second section - Biblical Connections - works with the reader on the scriptures used by MacArthur in the chapter. The scriptures come from both the old and new testaments to truly provide you with an overall view of the plan of God. The third section - Highlighting

the Lesson - focus on the central points made by MacArthurThe fourth section - Lasting Implications - helps the student apply the chapter and the scriptures to their own life.We used this in our older generation Sunday school class. The participation kept growing each week and we were ended up with participants across the generations and lively, thought provoking discussion.I highly recommend this as a Sunday school class for adults.

This inspiring book, authored by John MacArthur, explains so very well why Christ chose these historical individuals (just 12 ordinary men) men to be closest to Him. By reading this book one will have a much better understanding of each of the disciples and the reason they were selected. Dr. MacArthur is a wonderful writer, a very knowledgeable teacher and a dynamic preacher--my wife and I have been blessed to find him through this age of digitalization. Bob Smith
